Parishioners celebrate Geneva priest's new title

Parishioners at **St. Peter** Catholic Church in Geneva helped their priest Sunday celebrate his new monsignor title with a Mass in his honor. The honorary title was officially granted in November by Pope John Paul II to reward Rev. Joe **Jarmoluk** for serving as diocese coordinator of the Pope John Paul II Cultural Center in Washington, D.C.

The center "is a place where all Americans can come together to learn about the Catholic faith," **Jarmoluk** said. "It's a place of learning."

The new title means **Jarmoluk** is now a member of the papal household, which allows him to participate when the pope celebrates solemn mass and to be present in all public celebrations in which the pope, cardinals and papal retainers assist.

"The greater privilege for me is being a priest of Jesus Christ," **Jarmoluk** said.
